

DNA: Irinel Popescu, Vasile Ciurchea, former heads of CNAS, sent to trial over bribe taking

Irinel Popescu and Vasile Ciurchea, former heads of the National Health Insurance House (CNAS), have been sent to trial by the prosecutors of the National Anti-corruption Directorate (DNA) in a case in which they are being accused of bribe taking and abuse of office, for illegally concluding a series of appendixes allowing the award of overvalued agreements, involving a damage of more than 8 million euros against the CNAS, the DNA informed on Wednesday.
