

DNA: Irinel Popescu, Vasile Ciurchea, former heads of CNAS, sent to trial over bribe taking

**Irinel Popescu and Vasile Ciurchea, former heads of the National Health Insurance House (CNAS), have been sent to trial by the prosecutors of the National Anti-corruption Directorate (DNA) in a case in which they are being accused of bribe taking and abuse of office, for illegally concluding a series of appendixes allowing the award of overvalued agreements, involving a damage of more than 8 million euros against the CNAS, the DNA informed on Wednesday.**
